I am so sorry for what transpired at USC last Friday. I know how hard this was on so many people, especially considering the timing. We are committed to learning from this experience and putting processes in place to better manage these challenges in the future.

To that end, I have asked Provost Andrew Guzman, Dean Willow Bay of our USC Annenberg School for Communication and Journalism, and leadership from our Department of Public Safety to conduct a thorough review. Once we have a fuller understanding, we look forward to having a productive conversation with you with answers to your questions. I can report that the USC Annenberg School for Communication and Journalism will not be continuing its agreement with the Yunus Emre Institute.

Our hearts remain with the Armenian community who have been impacted by the grave humanitarian crisis taking place in Nagorno-Karabakh, as well as the many members of our USC community who we know are hurting, as well. I hope we can speak soon.
